#### **Executive Summary**

- ➤ The report covers global trade activities from January 2024 to April 2025 under HS Code 630260.
- ➤ Peak trade value reached \$9.06 billion in January 2025, indicating significant market events.
- India was the leading exporter with an export value of \$10.39 billion.

A sharp decline in trade activities was noted by April 2025, with values dropping to \$0.0. The United States emerged as the top importer, showcasing its influence in the global market.

- > Investors should consider strategic investments in technology-driven supply chain solutions and monitor global economic indicators.
