SBP to launch 2nd phase of instant digital payment system in October

KARACHI: State Bank of Pakistan (SBP) was set to launch the second phase of an instant digital payment system known as Raast within the next couple of months, which would allow person-to-person payments (P2P), it said on Wednesday.

Rupee appreciates

KARACHI: The rupee recouped losses to end stronger on Wednesday due to easing demand from importers, with dealers expecting to see the local unit stable in the days ahead.

Intervention price for cotton fixed at Rs5000/40kg

ISLAMABAD: The government has approved cotton intervention price of Rs5,000/40kg for cotton crop 2021-22 in bid to encourage farmers to revive the shrinking crop, country's top agriculture executive said on Wednesday.

KE submits additional Rs140bln investment plan to NEPRA
