Red Sea attacks hit global trade

OSLO/PARIS: Maersk and CMA CGM, two of the world's largest shipping firms, will impose extra charges after deciding to re-route ships following attacks on vessels in the Red Sea, as worries about the disruption to global trade grow.

Up to 10.11pc increase in price of RLNG for Dec 2023

The Oil and Gas Regulatory Authority (Ogra) on Friday notified a raise in the price of RLNG up to 10.11 percent for consumers for December 2023 as compared with the previous month of November. According to the notification, Ogra states, "The increase in RLNG prices is due to increase in DES price."

SPI-based weekly inflation soars 42.60pc YoY

ISLAMABAD: The Sensitive Price Index-based inflation for the week ended 21st December 2023, increased by 42.60 percent on a year-on-year basis, mainly due to an increase in the prices of gas charges (1,108.59 per cent), wheat flour (78.80 per cent), and sugar (50.33 per cent), the PBS said.

Open market: SBP unveils new exchange rate mechanism

KARACHI: In order to ensure transparency and credibility to the process of compiling open market exchange rate, the State Bank of Pakistan (SBP) has announced the mechanism to issue/publish end of the day open market exchange rates of select foreign currencies.

THE RUPEE PKR: upward climb

KARACHI: The Pakistani rupee continued its upward climb against the US dollar for the ninth successive session as it appreciated 0.09% in the inter-bank market on Friday. As per the State Bank of Pakistan (SBP), the rupee settled at 282.53 after an increase of Re0.26.

Cotton market remains dull

LAHORE: The trading in the local market on Friday remained dull. Cotton analyst, Naseem Usman while talking to Business Recorder said that the rate of cotton in Sindh is in between Rs 15,500 per maund to Rs 18,000 per maund. The rate of Phutti in Sindh is in between Rs 5,000 to Rs 7,000 per 40 kg.

RLNG price raised amid high system losses

ISLAMABAD: With system losses touching a record 14.5 per cent, the OGRA on Friday notified about 10pc increase in the sale price of RLNG for two Sui gas companies – SSGCL and SNGPL — for the current month with effect from Dec 1 owing to higher international prices, particularly of two spot cargoes.

Short-term inflation stays above 42pc

ISLAMABAD: Led by the historic gas price shock and some essential eatables, the short-term inflation measured by the Sensitive Price Index (SPI) went up by 42.6pc in the week ending Dec 21 on an annual basis. This is the 6th week in a row that the weekly inflation index has stood above 41pc,

UK economy shrinks before election year

LONDON: Britain's economy unexpectedly shrank in the third quarter and flatlined in the previous three months, official data showed on Friday, raising fears of a recession before an election due next year.
