KARACHI: Gold prices continued their uptrend on Saturday as global market hovered close to \$2, 700 per ounce, traders said. Gold further gained a sizeable value by Rs1400 to Rs280,800 per tola and Rs1201 to Rs240,741 per 10 grams, All Sindh Saraf Jewellers Association said.

Modest trading on cotton market

Exports to Europe rise to \$3.8bn in July-Nov

ISLAMABAD: Exports to European countries grew 8.62 per cent in the first five months of the current fiscal year, mainly due to higher shipments to western states. The resurgence in exports to Europe in the current fiscal year was due to a slight increase in demand for Pakistani goods in western, eastern and northern Europe.

KARACHI: Pakistan utilised 63 per cent of inflows it received through the Roshan Digital Acc-ount (RDA) by the end of Decem-ber 2024, reported the State Bank of Pakistan on Saturday. Since the launch of RDA on Sept 10, 2020, the country has received over \$9.34 billion, and \$5.911 billion has been utilised, reveals the SBP data.

Bangladesh relaxes visa conditions for Pakistanis

Foreign exchange reserves hit 3-year high at \$18.7bn

KARACHI: Pakistan's total foreign exchange assets reached a three-year high of \$18.7 billion as of November 2024, providing support to the country's external account. "Pakistan's total Foreign Exchange (FX) assets (liquid reserves plus gold) stood at a three-year high of \$18.7 billion as of November 2024.

Power sector circular debt increases by 3.09pc to Rs2.467tr in first quarter

ISLAMABAD: The circular debt in the power sector has swooped upward to Rs2.467 trillion with an increase of Rs74 billion in the first quarter of the current financial year, from Rs2.393 trillion registered on June 30, 2024.

Export industry seeks SIFC nod for energy supplies under deregulated RLNG regime

ISLAMABAD: The export-oriented industrial sector has rejected the alternative proposal of the government asking for an increase in gas or RLNG prices for captive power consumers to Rs4,100 per MMBtu, plus a 5 percent levy, with further gradual increases in the base price and the levy to 20 percent over the next 18 months.

Pakistan's net metering capacity surges 294pc, raising grid concerns

ISLAMABAD: Pakistan's net metering power capacity has surged to over 2,498 MWs in FY2023-24, up from 633 MWs in 2021-22, marking a 294 per cent increase over the past two years.
