125 demands for grants approved: NA rejects over 200 cut motions

ISLAMABAD: The National Assembly on Sunday approved 125 demands for grants exceeding Rs4.40 trillion for various ministries and divisions, while rejecting more than 200 cut motions moved by opposition lawmakers, in a move to secure funding for government expenditure through the financial year ending June 30, 2027.

NA body told: Many amendments incorporated in Finance Bill

ISLAMABAD: Major amendments have been proposed in the Finance Bill 2026 to incorporate key recommendations of the National Assembly and Senate Standing Committees on Finance including reduction in import duties and taxes on mobile phones valuing USD31-USD200.

NA body approves key safeguards

ISLAMABAD: The National Assembly Standing Committee on Finance approved a number of key amendments including strengthened legal safeguard providing that no freezing order against property held by a third party may be issued unless the Special Judge records written reasons and affords the affected person an opportunity of being heard,

PM forms high-level body on Telecom Reorganisation Bill

ISLAMABAD: Amid mounting political scrutiny and public concern over property rights, Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif on Sunday ordered the formation of a high-level committee to urgently review controversial provisions of the Telecom-munication Reorganisation (Amendment) Bill, 2026, particularly clauses governing right-of-way access for telecom infrastructure.

Govt set to hand over PIA to new owners by month-end

ISLAMABAD: The government is set to hand over Pakistan International Airlines (PIA) to its new owners by the end of the current month, as all remaining codal formalities and documentation have been completed.

Marginal gain

KARACHI: The Pakistani rupee continued to post marginal gain against the US dollar, appreciating 0.03 percent in the inter-bank market during the previous week. The local unit closed the week at 278.25, a gain of Re0.07 against 278.32 it had closed the earlier week.

Punjab misses cotton cultivation target by 18pc

LAHORE: Punjab has recorded a sharp decline in cotton cultivation during the current cotton year 2026-27, missing the provincial target by 18 per cent and raising fears of higher cotton and edible oil imports in the coming months.

Normal speed limits reinstated on motorways, highways

ISLAMABAD: The government on Sunday withdrew its decision to temporarily reduce speed limits on motorways and national highways, restoring the previously prescribed limits. The speed limit for cars and light transport vehicles (LTVs) on motorways has been restored to 120km per hour,

NA panel finalises key recommendations on Finance Bill 2026

ISLAMABAD: The National Assembly's Standing Committee on Finance has finalised its key recommendations on Finance Bill 2026-27, including slashing import duties on mobile phones valued at \$31 to \$200, extending sales tax exemption to all airlines from July 1, 2027 and changing special excise duty on luxury and Electric Vehicles (EVs).

Pakistan receives 7th LNG cargo today since ME tensions

ISLAMABAD: Pakistan is set to receive on Monday (today) its seventh LNG cargo since regional tensions intensified following the Iran-US conflict, as the country continues efforts to secure adequate gas supplies.
