IT return deadline extended till 30th

ISLAMABAD: The Federal Board of Revenue (FBR) has provisionally collected Rs 512 billion in October 2022 against the assigned monthly target of Rs534 billion, reflecting a shortfall of Rs 22 billion.

PM hopes to revive CPEC, expand trade with maiden China visit

ISLAMABAD: Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif is embarking on a two-day official visit to China on Tuesday (today) in an effort to revive the multi-billion-dollar China-Pakistan Economic Corridor (CPEC), expand trade and investment ties with the neighbouring country by making optimal use of the second phase of the China-Pakistan Free Trade Agreement.

Three CPEC projects get swift nod on eve of PM's China visit

ISLAMABAD: Hours before Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif's visit to Beijing, back-to-back meetings of various forums approved almost \$12 billion worth of three major projects for inclusion in the multi-billion-dollar CPEC and cleared a longstanding demand by Chinese investors for escrow accounts for automatic payment of their dues against electricity supply.

Give Opec+ a phone call if world needs more oil: UAE minister

ABU DHABI: The United Arab Emirates' energy minister said on Monday that Opec+ is willing to provide the world with the oil it needs, and that if consumers require more, the alliance of top producers was "only a phone call away".

OGDC, PPL to invest in Reko Dig

KARACHI: Two state-owned energy companies listed on the Pakistan Stock Exchange said on Monday that they have negotiated and finalised, along with Government Holdings Pakistan Ltd, the definitive agreements for their respective participation in the reconstituted Reko Diq project.

FBR misses October's collection target

ISLAMABAD: After exceeding projections for several months, the Federal Board of Revenue (FBR) missed its collection target for October by 17 per cent, or Rs88 billion, owing to a sharp drop in imports, showed provisional data on Monday.

US dollar falls by Rs1.58

KARACHI: The US dollar's four-day rally ended on Monday after it lost Rs1.58 against the rupee to close at Rs220.89 in the interbank market. The dollar had been appreciating against the local currency during the last week hitting Rs222.47 on Oct 28.

Govt to clear all LCs worth \$100,000: Ishaq Dar

ISLAMABAD: Federal Minister for Finance Ishaq Dar on Monday announced keeping prices of POL products unchanged for the next 15 days with effect from November 1, 2022. He also announced clearance of LCs up to \$50,000 and also granted a month extension in the filing of Income Tax returns up to November 30, 2022.

EU seeks Pak influence to help export grain from Ukraine

ISLAMABAD: In an unusual diplomatic twitter communication on Monday, the European Union Ambassador to Pakistan, Ms Riina Kionka, publicly asked the Ministry of Foreign Affairs to use its influence and ensure that Russia starts moving its ships to export grain from Ukraine.

Threefold increase: SNGPL commercial users now to pay Rs3,763 a unit

LAHORE: The natural gas tariff for the commercial consumers of Sui Northern Gas Pipelines Ltd (SNGPL) has seen a major jump. The per unit price for the commercial consumers has been converted from cheap system gas to the costly imported RLNG.

300,000-tonne wheat to be imported from Russia

ISLAMABAD: The Economic Coordination Committee (ECC) of the Cabinet on Monday approved import of 300,000 tonnes of wheat from Russia on the government-to-government deal at a cost of \$372 per tonne.
