FDI drops 47pc to \$253.4m in July-Sept

KARACHI: Pakistan's foreign direct investment (FDI) fell 47.1 percent to \$253.4 million in the first quarter of the current fiscal year, driven by weak inflows especially from China, UK, and USA, the central bank's data showed.

Pakistan forex reserves inch up to \$13.250 billion
