1. Phase I Completed (2025): TMA, with the Green Pakistan Project, successfully initiated compliance work. 13 members already achieved
2. Phase II Launch (2026): Now expanding to cover all parts of CSDDD, with stronger systems and tools for members.

Understanding CSDDD

CSDDD = Corporate Sustainability Due Diligence Directive

Term	Practical Implication
Corporate	Responsibility lies with the legal entity (the corporation), not just individuals.
Sustainability	Companies must respect human rights, labor standards, and environmental integrity across supply chains.
Due	Firms must act reasonably and proportionately to meet compliance duties.
Diligence	Requires proactive identification, prevention, and mitigation of risks in operations and supply chains.
Directive	Creates a common framework across the EU, with flexibility for national implementation.
